

Download 1938 Allis Chalmers Model B Service Manual

The Allis-Chalmers model B was the result of research by Harry Merritt, Allis tractor division manager, into U.S. farm sizes in the early 1930s. The Allis Chalmers WD model tractor was produced in 1948, 1949, 1950, 1951, 1952 and 1953 in West Allis, Wisconsin. It has a 201 ci engine rated at 28 horsepower. Allis-Chalmers model IB tractors built prior to 1946 shared serial numbers with the B farm tractors. Based on the B, the Allis IB industrial tractor featured a heavier frame, front axle, and foot throttle.
